## A June 2017 Update from Dr. Eugene Sanders

### Ontario School is Moving to the Adams Building

All students who are currently attending Ontario Elementary School will be moving to the Adams Building (former junior high school building), located at 318 Columbus Avenue. Ontario students and faculty will be housed there for the next two years. Only Ontario students will be housed in the building. The reason for the movement of students is a result of the district's Building Better Dreams facilities program, in which three new schools will be built over the next several years.

### Frequently Asked Questions for Ontario Elementary Students and Families:

#### How will I get to school at the Adams building?

All Ontario students will attend classes at the Adams Building beginning the first day of school on August 30, 2017. If you live more than one half mile from the Adams Building, you will have bus transportation (same rule in the district for many years). We are reviewing our transportation policy to determine the best way to serve our students during the transition.

#### Will there be a formal celebration of the legacy of Ontario School?

There are plans to celebrate the wonderful legacy and memories of Ontario School. Join us from 10:00 am - 2:00 pm on Thursday, July 20 and from 5:00 pm - 7:00 pm on Thursday, July 27.

#### Will the same teachers, support staff and principal that currently work at Ontario be assigned to the Adams Building?

Yes, all current teachers, support staff and principal will be moving to the Adams Building, right along with the students.

## An Update from Lesko Architecture

### Design of the New Schools

Following our meeting with the Administration, Educators, and Staff to define your educational program needs, the design team began developing the floor plans for each building. This is the part of the process we call the Schematic Design phase. During this phase we develop the floor plans for each school and show the sizes and the relationships of all of the rooms. Some of the major spaces in each building include the Administration Offices, Classrooms, Computer Labs, Cafeteria, Gymnasium, and Media Center. We also complete the design of the building sites in this phase that includes vehicle circulation, bus and parent drop-off areas, and parking. Preliminary plans were completed and reviewed again with the District. We are currently finalizing all of the building and site plans and are in the process of creating three-dimensional images of each school.

### Renovations to Sandusky Middle School & High School

Work is ready to begin on the Auditorium stage relief air venting system and roofing which will be completed before the start of school in the fall. As we previously indicated, the other renovations, including Science Rooms, Rooms 300/301, Natatorium and Planetarium are currently in the design phase and will be ready to begin construction next summer 2018.
