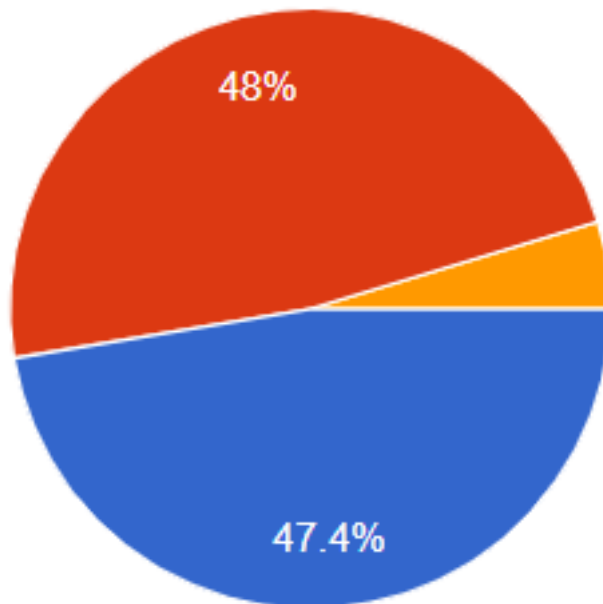




End-of-Year Survey Results

What is your role?



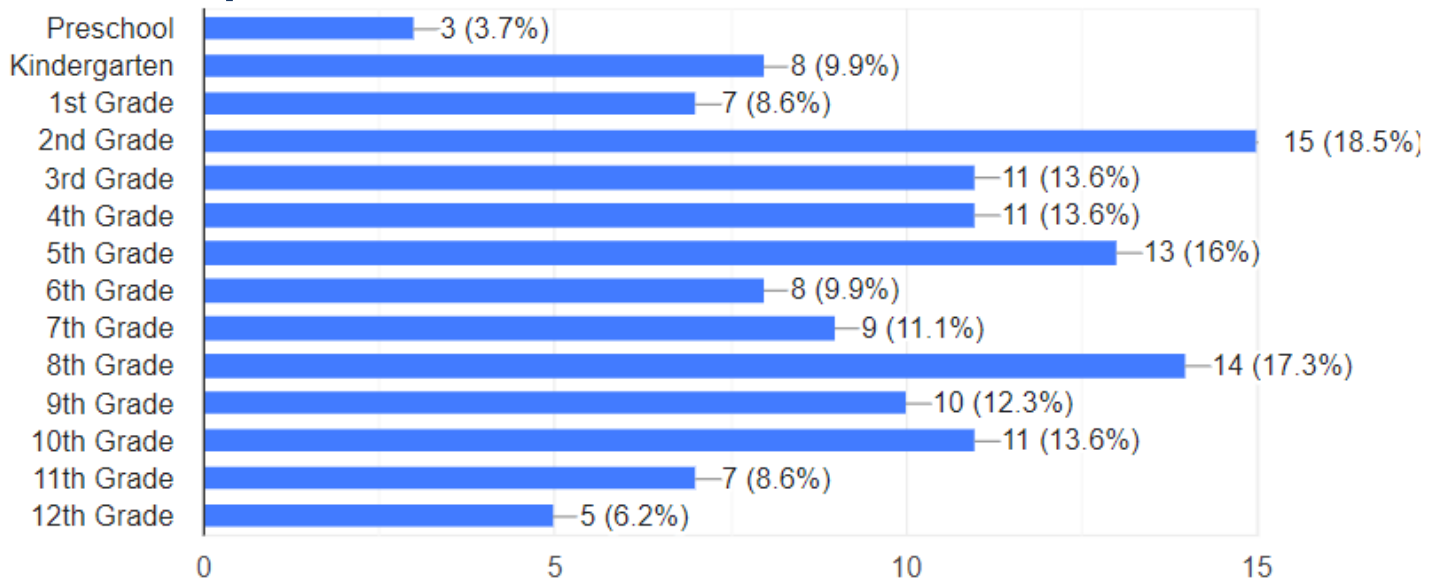

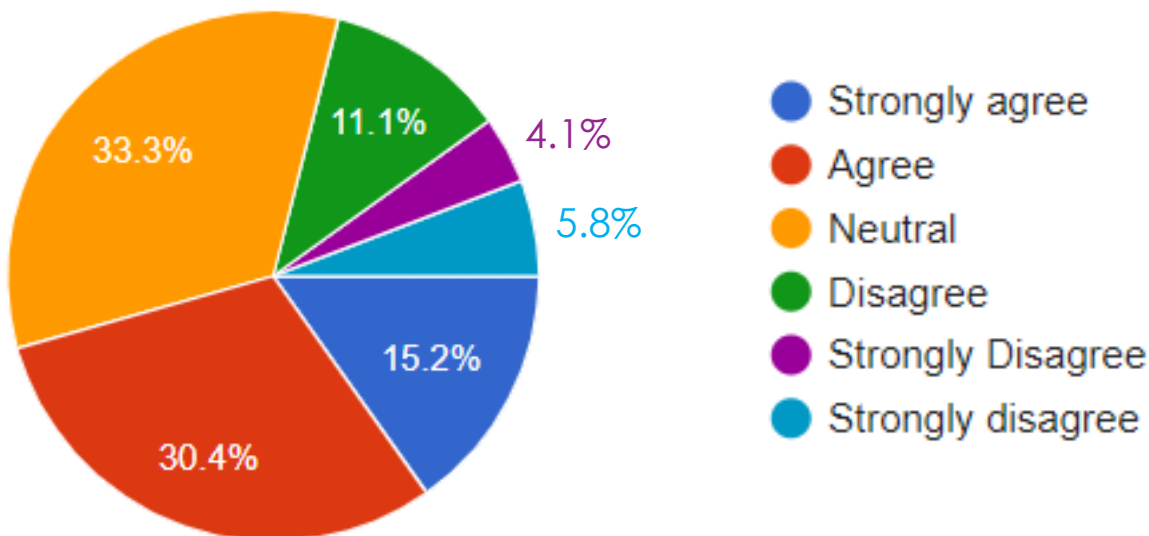
Please check all grade levels that apply to your student(s) this school year:

I feel district communications has improved this school year.

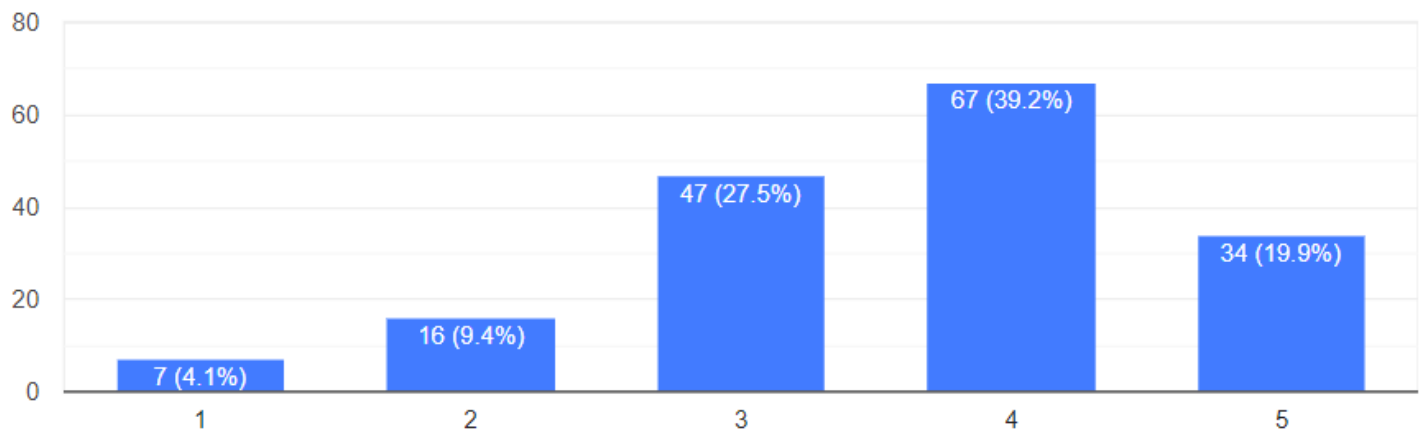
