Design of the New Schools

The Construction Manager at Risk is in the process of reviewing the Construction Documents for all three new buildings. These are the drawings and specifications the contractors will follow to build the new schools. As soon as that process is completed, the drawings will be issued to contractors to submit bids for building the new schools. Ontario and the Intermediate Schools are still on schedule to begin this month with the construction of the Hancock School to follow in Summer of 2019.

Abatement and demolition of the Ontario building has been completed and the Contractor is finishing the site work. The site preparation is on schedule to be completed this month and in time to begin the construction of the new school.

The Construction Manager at Risk secured bids for completing the site work at the Intermediate School in preparation for the start of the new school construction. The contractors are mobilizing their work force to begin site grading, installation of utilities and removal of the existing Hospital foundations.

Renovations to Sandusky Middle School and High School The Construction Manager at Risk received bids from Contractors for the renovations and upgrades to the Science Rooms, Rooms 300/301, Planetarium and Auditorium. The projects were awarded to the contractors and they are in the process of ordering materials to be ready for renovations beginning this summer. The work is on schedule to be completed by the start of school in the Fall.
