Dean Sheldon, Jr. has been honored by the Ohio Dept. of Natural Resources for his work in recognition of his efforts to generate interest in the outdoors, promote resource conservation, and in helping bluebirds become re-established in our area. He has also served as program chairman of the Ohio Blue Bird Society, to this day maintaining a bluebird trail with over 150 nest boxes. Dean served as the first Director of Erie Metroparks. Among his endeavors was the purchase of a 30 acre farm in Huron County that he worked to renovate into a wildlife conservation area. He has planted thousands of trees and developed ponds and wetlands and established erosion control practices. Since 1982 Dean has maintained as many as 125 bluebird boxes in Huron, Ashland & Richland Counties. Sheldon joins his father, **Dean Sheldon, Sr.**, in the ODNR Hall of Fame. Good job, Dean !!!

1955. Nancy (Franketti) McKeen was presented the 2009 Chairman’s Award for providing special service to the Erie County Chamber of Commerce, and whose service has particularly impressed the Chairman of the Board.

1968. John Feick received the Erie County Chamber of Commerce Community Service Award for 2008 for his demonstration of superior pursuit of activities beyond normal professional or vocational involvement that has benefited the area.

1973. Ken Taylor reports the audience is growing for his National Public Radio, “Philosophy Talk.” “I think we’re about to have a major breakthrough,” Taylor said. “We’re being picked up by more stations.” The hour long show is still mostly carried by public radio stations in Oregon and California but also is heard over stations in Louisiana and New York and has just been added by more stations across the United States. The shows strategy is “to get into all of the urban markets and all of the college towns, where thinking people congregate,” Taylor said. Radio listeners “are hungry for serious reflection that doesn’t talk down to them,” he said. The show isn’t carried by radio stations in Ohio yet, but Erie county residents can listen to streaming video at the show’s web site, philosophytalk.org, or visit the show’s Facebook page. Taylor’s academic career is also going well. Stanford appointed him to an endowed chair, the Henry Walgrave Stuart Professor of Philosophy. Taylor has been chairman of Stanford’s philosophy department but gave up the administrative post - giving himself more time to write, think and teach. He returns to Sandusky once or twice a year to visit his parents.

1974. Marian (Thompson) Ralph-Abrams will be remembered as being a role model, the first black to become an accredited literacy specialist in Ohio. But she will be missed as a generous and graceful mother, friend and teacher. Abrams died February 12 after battling colon cancer for more than a year. She worked throughout her illness as a mentor coach and literacy specialist and retired only weeks ago on Feb. 1, 2009. Abrams prided herself on being a role model for black students in the Sandusky Schools, where she worked for 30 years at Venice Heights, Ontario and Hancock Elementary schools before moving into the administration building as a specialist. She was the first black majorette of the Sandusky High School band and eventually became the first head majorette.

1976. Susan (Cottier) Davie recently joined the staff of the Dental Specialty Group in Norwalk, Ohio. Davie received her associate degree from Owens Technical College and has more than 29 years of dental hygiene experience. As a dental hygienist, Davie is trained to professionally clean teeth, teach patients how to practice good oral hygiene, and provide other preventative dental care.

1994. Orlando Pace, a seven time Pro-Bowl offensive tackle dogged by injuries in recent seasons, was released by the St. Louis Rams on March 10, 2009. He was the first overall pick of the 1997 draft. Owner Chip Rosenbloom said in a statement that Pace would be remembered as "one of the finest Rams of all time." Pace started 14 games last year, but missed half of 2007 and virtually all of 2006 because of injuries. "I can't begin to thank Orlando for all he has meant to the Rams organization." Rosenbloom added. "It is never easy to end a relationship that has had as much success as ours, but in the interest of Orlando and the Rams, we feel now is the right time." The former Ohio State star was selected to seven straight Pro-Bowls from 1999-2005 and started in two Super Bowls, including the franchise's lone title after the 1999 season. "Orlando Pace has been a mainstay on the Rams' offensive line since he was drafted in 1997, and he has proven to be one of the most efficient offensive tackles throughout his career," General Manager Billy Devaney said.
