Strobel Field at Cedar Point Stadium is officially open for use!

A special and grand thank you goes out to all community members and organizations who made this exciting installation possible. With the commitment of funding from organizations like Wightman-Wieber Foundation, Frost-Parker Foundation & Cedar Point and individuals like Orlando Pace, we were able to move forward with the turf project, despite not receiving the grant from the NFL Grassroots Committee.

The construction began in May, causing graduation to be held inside, but enabling the project to be done just in time. By the end of June, the grass field

was gone, having been completely excavated and leveled. By the end of July, the new carpet started being laid. What you see before you today is twelve full weeks of hard work, and the result is truly beautiful. The dedication ceremony was August 26th before the first home game of the season vs. Fremont Ross. Prior to the 6:15 pm ceremony, there was a tailgate party, hosted by the Booster Club and Alumni Association.


