Blue Streak University

Who?

For all 7th-12th graders who have tested college-ready by successfully meeting university entrance exam requirements.

What?

This program is designed to allow students to earn college credit while enrolled at SHS/SMS. Grades are included in both high school and college grade point average.

Where?

Classes are taught at Sandusky High School, as a blend of on-site at SHS and online, or on the college/university partner campus (BGSU Firelands, LCCC, Terra State).

When?

Students can access Blue Streak University as early as the 7th grade if they successfully meet requirements.

Why?

Blue Streak University provides a significant college savings to parents and students and also allows for an advanced college standing upon graduation.

How?

Students will take a college-readiness exam in the fall. If a student tests "college-ready", he or she is admitted to Blue Streak University and is able to take college level courses. If a student does not meet the entrance exam entrance requirement, they can re-test in fall of the following year.
