## **Family Health Services Clinic at Sandusky High School**

*Sandusky, Ohio.* Family Health Services (FHS) is partnering with Sandusky City Schools (SCS) to open a school based health clinic in Sandusky High School. This clinic will be available for Sandusky City Schools students in grades 7-12, all district staff, and Sandusky Career Center students. Services offered will include acute physical health services, behavioral health services, vaccinations, wellness checks, physicals, and much more.

Dr. Stephen Sturgill, SCS Chief of Staff and Transformation Officer states, “We could not be more excited to be partnering with Family Health Services to offer a clinic in Sandusky High School. Students will no longer need to leave school to receive medical services, which will help improve attendance and academics. Having easy access to a health clinic that offers both physical and mental care is just another step we are taking to address all needs of every student.”
