A February 2018 Update from Lesko Architecture

Design of the New Schools

The Construction Documents for the three new buildings have been completed and turned over to the Construction Manager at Risk (CMR) to review and solicit bids from Contractors. Construction on the Primary and the Intermediate Schools is scheduled to begin in April 2018 with the Pre-K/Kindergarten School construction to follow in Summer of 2019.

If anyone travels past the Ontario site, they will see that most of the existing building has been demolished and the debris is being removed from the site. The contractors are working to remove the existing building foundations and that work is scheduled to be complete in April 2018 to be ready to begin construction of the new school.

Preparation work continues at the Intermediate School site. The CMR has secured bids for completing the site work which includes site grading, installation of utilities and removal of the existing hospital below ground foundations. Windscreens have been installed on the fencing around the site as we prepare for construction to begin.

Renovations to Sandusky Middle School and High School

The CMR is currently receiving bids from Contractors for the renovations and upgrades to the Science Rooms, Rooms 300/301, Planetarium and Auditorium. Materials, such as the Science Rooms cabinetry, will be ordered immediately, to be ready for demolition and construction to begin as soon as school is out for Summer break. A great deal of work will be completed in a relatively short time to be ready for the start of school in the Fall.
