What are key skills for someone in the hospitality industry?

To work in hospitality, you need good customer service skills to keep guests happy, the ability to work well with a team, and the ability to stay calm when things don't go as planned. It also helps to know about food safety, managing restaurants, bartending, and using time wisely.

What can I expect the salary of a hospitality employee to be?

The average entry-level salary in Ohio is \$32,220 per year or \$16.11 per hour. Entry-level positions start at \$29,250 annually, while most experienced workers make up to \$52,592 annually.
