Sean Bittinger, a member of the SHS Class of 1999, has built an interesting and successful career in technology arts and special effects (VFX) in San Francisco, CA. He may be far from home but not our hearts.

In 2003, Sean earned a BA in Media Technology and Arts from Denison University in Granville, OH and moved to San Francisco to begin his career. After a couple years in the computer tech field at various SF companies, he landed his dream job at ILM (Industrial Light and Magic, the premier VFX studio division of Lucas Films, later bought by Disney.)

Sean's career at ILM took him through the ranks of VFX roles (graphics, tech directing, and compositing) for films such as **Avatar**, **Avengers**, **Black Panther**, **Deep Water Horizon**, **Ready Player One**, **Star Trek**, **Star Wars**, **Unbroken**....the extensive list goes on and on. Sean more recently moved to Microsoft & Arcturus Studios as a technical artist and product specialist in virtual reality production. Next December, for the first time in 67 years, the Sandusky Blue Streaks swim team will be competing in a beautiful new pool at Sandusky High School. They will be the first team to jump off the new starting blocks.

But it is the work of another team –ThenDesign Architects and Mosser Construction—who not only installed the swim team's starting blocks, but designed and built the entire Sandusky Aquatic Center to accommodate all swimmers, young, old, and in between, for many years to come.



And all of this was made possible by another team who jumped in first and foremost— the extraordinary visionaries who shared the dreams of the swimmers,

the builders, and our community. The City of Sandusky, the Randolph J. and Estelle M. Dorn Foundation, the Mylander Foundation and the Sandusky YMCA Foundation provided more than half of the \$5M in philanthropic support of the project, with the school district contributing the remaining \$4M in necessary funds. This spirit of enthusiastic, optimistic and enduring generosity is deeply rooted in our community, and the way


