Requests for the use of funds to be made, in writing, to the Superintendent of Schools from the Band Director. Instruments purchased from fund are to remain property of Sandusky City Schools. First priority for use of income shall go to assist individual students of the band. If income from fund exceeds amount required to meet this obligation in any given calendar year, the Superintendent of Schools may authorize purchase of instruments or equipment which benefit the band program. Consideration for Orchestra students shall only be made on an exceptional, individual review basis. The extension of funding for Orchestra can only be expedited so long as the needs of the band have been met.
