1943 Warren Foster celebrated his 85th birthday at the U.S. Masters National Swim Championships held at the 1996 Olympic pool at Georgia Tech in Atlanta. Foster won the 400 yd. Individual Medley in 10:58.72 for his 10th national title in the past 10 years. He added 2nd place in the 500 yd Freestyle, the 100 x 200 yd IM's and 3rd in the 100 yd. butterfly. The meet attracted over 1,971 swimmers with 13 in Foster's 85-89 age bracket. A swim coach for 30 yrs., he was the 1st coach at the Marion "Y" in 1953 and later at Ontario High School, Lima Shawnee High School and finally at Marion Harding High School. At Sandusky he swam 6 years Jr. & Sr. high and at B.G.S.U. and in the Navy. After WWII he managed the O.S.U. team for 3 years. Foster retired from O.S.U. Marion where he taught sailing, golf, and bowling.

Now those who are left Are forgotten, but why?


Our forgotten veterans They should come first They went through hell They suffered the worst.

It has been my pleasure to work for the Sandusky City School District for the past eight years (2002-2010) as the superintendent and previously for seventeen years (1968-1985) as a teacher. Those twenty-five years have passed by very quickly, but after forty-two years in the education profession I am looking forward to retirement. The past eight years have been great and I wish to thank the Board, our staff and the community for all of the cooperation and support that has been given to the District. Many positive things have taken place through some very difficult times and I feel very fortunate to have been a part of the storied history of the Sandusky School District.

During the past eight years we have seen steady improvement on our annual state report card that includes not only elevated test scores, but higher graduation rates and a narrowing of the achievement gap. Technology has exploded and it continues to drive the District. The voters of Sandusky have continued their strong financial support for the school district with the passage of several important levies. Additionally, with the consolidation of several buildings and reductions in staffing we have saved the taxpayers millions of dollars and at the same time strengthened our academic program. The addition of pre-school classes has provided a very positive impact for our youngsters entering school.

Looking ahead, the District continues to look for ways to save money. Grants financially drive many of our academic programs. Alternative sources of energy, such as wind turbines and solar panels, are being investigated. Sandusky High School is a single-campus comprehensive building that provides a wealth of offerings to our students both academically and in the field of career technology. Mandarin Chinese is one example of the farsighted vision of the District. The Sandusky City School District is in the second year of the Ohio Improvement Process (completely paid for by the Ohio Department of Education) in which all Ohio districts will be required to participate (at their expense) in the years ahead.

Lastly, the Sandusky City School District is seeing tremendous growth in our athletic programs. We see pride in our students as they come to school neatly dressed in their blue and white tops with contrasting khaki pants. Our athletes wear their blue blazers with a white shirt and tie as they travel to games and events. On the athletic field, on the court, and in the gym they are competing at a much higher level with much more success than we have seen in years.
