A January 2018 Update from Lesko Architecture

Design of the New Schools

The next few months will be an exciting time as we move closer to beginning construction of the Ontario and Intermediate Schools. As an update, the team did secure approval of the Ontario and Hancock Schools site plans at the Board of Zoning Appeals December meeting.

The Construction Documents for the three new schools will be completed by January 26. These are the documents that are used by the Construction Manager to obtain bids from Contractors who want to be part of the team that builds the new schools. Once the bids are received and the work awarded to contractors, construction will begin on Ontario and the Intermediate Schools which is scheduled to start in April.

The construction fence to enclose the work area for safety has been installed at the Intermediate School site adjacent to the Middle/High School and preliminary site construction work has begun. In addition, the abatement of the existing Ontario school has been completed and demolition of the existing school will begin shortly and be completed by April 2018.

Renovations to Sandusky Middle School & High School

The Construction Documents for the renovations and upgrades to the Science Rooms, Rooms 300/301, Planetarium and Auditorium are now complete and have been released to the Construction Manager team. They are in the process of reviewing the documents and sending them out to contractors to bid the projects for construction.

In addition, portions of the renovations, such as cabinetry, are currently being secured ahead of the rest of the project to make certain that the materials are ordered and arrive in time for installation this summer. These projects are on schedule to begin as soon as school lets out for the Summer 2018 and be completed in time for the start of school in the Fall.
